### PRIVACY POLICY

THIS PRIVACY POLICY (“POLICY”) GOVERNS THE INFORMATION THAT THE AFRICAN LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (“ALA,” “we” OR “us”) COLLECTS THROUGH THIS GLOBAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM WEBSITE (“Website” OR “WEBSITE”) AND YOUR RELATED COMMUNICATIONS AND CORRESPONDENCE WITH ALA CONCERNING GSP SERVICES. YOUR USE OF THE WEBSITE AND THE GSP SERVICES IS THEREFORE SUBJECT TO THE AGREEMENT. BY USING THIS WEBSITE, YOU SIGNIFY YOUR ASSENT TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH ANY TERM IN THIS POLICY, PLEASE DO NOT USE THIS WEBSITE OR SUBMIT ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION THROUGH THIS WEBSITE.

1. Personal Information Collected. We collect information that can be used to identify you personally (“personal information”), such as your name, email address and telephone number. We do not collect any personal information about you unless you provide it voluntarily, including, without limitation, by filling out a form or survey; by requesting information; by registering an account and e-mail address with us; by signing up for an e-mail newsletter; or by otherwise communicating e-mailing us. If you do not want us to collect personal information about you, do not submit your personal information to ALA. As per section 18(4)a) of the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013, we will take reasonable steps to inform you when we are collecting your personal information.
2. Use of Personal Information. The primary purpose in collecting applicants personal information is to enable us to receive and assess applications for GSP services and to maintain communication with our GSP delegates (registrants) and their families. We also collect and use your information to send you information about GSP current activities, to keep you informed about future events, for Website administration, to improve our services and future services, and for the purpose of performing any other specific services for which such data was collected. We also use your personal information for marketing, promotional, and other commercial or non-commercial communications. For these purposes ALA may share applicants' and/or registrants' personal information with other persons such as employees, speakers, volunteers, service providers (including medical practitioners) and donors. ALA does not permit these parties to use such information for any other purpose than to perform the services that ALA has instructed them to provide. In some instances, ALA may also collect sensitive information about applicants or registrants, such as information about their membership to a professional or trade association or trade union, their health (including disability), their racial or ethnic origin, or any criminal record. Consent is obtained for the collection of such information. There may be occasions when ALA obtains personal information from a third party, for example through nominations. In this case nominated applicants will be informed of the privacy policy and the collection and use of their personal information by ALA.  
We may share aggregate or anonymized information about you and other Website users with third parties for marketing, advertising, research or similar purposes. For example The Google Display Network

beyond our reasonable control. We will, however, notify you of any security breach of your personal information.

6. Cross-Border Transfer of your Personal Information: GSP services are offered globally to persons from several countries and delivered through the work of various ALA employees, agents, service providers, networks etc. from several countries. Accordingly, please note that information we collect may be transferred to and processed to countries outside of your country. By using our Website and submitting your Information, you specifically consent to the transfer and processing of your information outside of your country, which may not have data protection laws that provide the same level of protection that exists in your country. Your consent is voluntary. If, you do not consent, then we may not, however be able to provide you with our GSP services.
7. Sharing of Personal Information. Except to provide our services to you, other purposes specified herein and for the reasons set out below, we do not share your information with other people or organisations:
  - As Required By, Or Permitted by Law: We may share your personally identifiable information as required by, or permitted by, law. This may include sharing your personally identifiable information with governmental entities, or third parties in response to warrants, court orders, other legal processes, or as we believe is necessary to exercise our legal rights, to defend against legal claims that have been brought against us, or to defend against possible legal claims that we determine in our sole discretion might be brought against us.
  - Protect Rights, Property, and Safety; and to Report Unlawful Activity. We may also share your personally identifiable information if we determine, in our sole judgment, that the release of your information may protect the rights, property, or safety of you or another person. In this instance we may share your information with law enforcement or any other person or entity we determine, in our sole judgment, may be able to protect you or the other person. We may also report to law enforcement agencies any activities that we reasonably believe to be unlawful, or that we reasonably believe may aid a law enforcement investigation into unlawful activity.
  - Third Party Websites and Payment Processors: Our Website, or our communications to you, may link to third parties' websites. It is also possible that third parties' websites or e-mails may link to our Website. We are not responsible for the content or the privacy practices employed by third parties. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of these websites before transmitting any personal information to third parties. Your payments to ALA through this Website are processed by third party payment processors and ALA does not maintain any records of your credit card or debit card information submitted through our Website.

Compliance with Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)(For US registrants): You represent and warrant that, in compliance with COPPA, you are over thirteen (13) years of age, alternatively that if you are registering a child under fourteen (14) years of age you are the parent or guardian of such child.
